SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS

1 Jurisdiction: This event is held under the national sporting code of the auto – cycle union, the standing regulations, supplementary regulations and any final instructions issued. The ACU sporting code and standing regulations are published annually in the ACU handbook.

2 Eligibility: Open to all solo classes, and youth members of a Southern Centre ACU club.

3 Entries: Through the ACU online entry system, there will be NO entry on the day, entries open on 14th September and close 28th October or when full. Entry fee £25 adult £15 youth.

4 Course: All on private land on the Somerley Estate, **maximum 90 riders**, 4 routes, 3 laps of 15 sections.

5 Classes: A Expert; B Clubman; C Sportsman, D Beginner, Twin shock B, Twin shock C Pre-65 B, Pre 65 C Youth A, Youth B, Youth C, Youth D.

6 Awards: Perce Simon trophy – Best Pre 65. C. Bernie Leigh trophy – Best Clubman B.

7 Results: will be posted on our website.

8 General: No toilets or catering at this event.

9 Child Protection: The Secretary of the Meeting is the point of contact (National Sporting Code 6.14)

10 Additional instruction page: Please ensure that you have read and follow all instructions contained on this page.

Ringwood MC & LCC supplementary regulations additional instruction sheet

Anyone who experiences or has experienced COVID – 19 symptoms within 14 days prior to the event must not attend.

Entry application and payment must be made online using the ACU online entry system.

Please do not travel to the event unless you have a confirmed entry if you do not have a confirmed entry you will not be allowed to enter the parking area.

Travel to/from the Event – only one person should travel in the vehicle, unless individuals are from the same household, then these persons may travel together.

Riders must adhere to all safety signage at the event.

No accommodation, camping, catering or toilets will be available at the event.

No Spectators are permitted, entry to the venue is restricted to competitor and their vehicle only.

Number of Competitors - restricted to **90**.

Youths should be accompanied by one parent/legal guardian or carer to support the rider. Should the rider fall, only the parent/legal guardian or carer should assist the rider.

Paired scoring method – a pair of riders can travel the Course. Each pair of riders will be given each other's score punch cards at sign on. The pair of riders will take it in turn to ride a section, one rider will record the score of the other rider.

Riders will start the trial at a nominated section number in groups of 6 (3 pairs).

A maximum of 6 riders (3 pairs) to be at a section at one time. Following riders must wait outside the section area until the pairs in front of them have completed the section and all moved on before entering that section area.

Inspecting sections prior to riding – only 6 riders (3 pairs) allowed into a section to inspect at any one time. It must be walked in the direction it is to be ridden, leaving the section through the end gate – one-way traffic only, do not walk back through the section.

Waiting at Sections - whilst waiting to negotiate a section, all riders are to adhere to social distancing requirements and signage at all times.

Section Markers and Score Cards - appropriate PPE (i.e. gloves) must be worn when handling markers and hand sanitiser to be used. At the end of the Event, section markers, score cards and punches will be disinfected.

Travelling Marshalls – travelling Marshalls will move around sections to ensure Social Distancing measures are being adhered to. For everyone's safety, they are to report any rider that is not following the virus safety measures to the Clerk of the Course for action to be taken, i.e. instructed to leave the event.

Signing on – the Competitor enters the event via the ACU online system, in doing so received a riding number for the event. They may choose another rider to pair up with giving their names in the question box. At signing on, the riders number card and their pairs partners score cards with a punch will be individually available at the control desk ready for collection. No One Day Licences will be issued.

Before during and after the event no competitor is to share or ride another competitors motorcycle.

Litter and Waste – it is the responsibility of each rider, Official, member of the public to take their own litter/waste away with them, a base requirement and Covid 19 mitigation.
