- 1 Announcement:** Ringwood MC & LCC will hold a trial open **to paid up members** riding solo motorcycles (including pre-65) at Ashley Hollow, Ringwood, Hampshire on the dates above.
- 2 Jurisdiction:** Held under the National Sporting Code of the Auto Cycle Union, the Standing Regulations, supplementary regulations and any final instructions issued. The ACU sporting code and standing regulations are published annually in the ACU handbook.
- 3 Entries:** Through the ACU online entry system only, there will be **NO** entry on the day. Entry fee **£15 adult/£10 youth**. No refunds will be accepted less than 72 hours before the event.
- 4 Course:** All on private land at Ashley Hollow, Ringwood, Hants, BH24 2DF. **Maximum 60 riders**, 4 routes, 3 laps, 10 sections.
- 5 Classes:** Expert, Clubman, Sportsman, Beginner, Twinshock, Pre-65, Youth. **Route options as detailed below.**
- 6 Results:** Will be posted on the website. **ringwood-mc-lcc.co.uk**
- 7 Sections:** To help complete this event in the time available riders will not be permitted to inspect sections after the first lap. Sections to be ridden in order.
- 8 Awards:** This event forms part of the 2021 summer series of closed to club trials and awards will be given for the best overall performances in each class. (best 4 results)
- 9 Child Protection:** The Secretary of the Meeting is the point of contact (NSC 6.14)
